Weigh-ins will be from 7:00 to 9:00 a.m. at #4. Lightweight men - 160 max, no averaging. Lightweight women - 130 max, no averaging. Same for masters.

All entries must be made on-line at Regatta Central (<http://www.regattacentral.com>) by 6 p.m. Friday, June 7. Entries received after this date will be accepted on a "lane available" basis and, if accepted, will incur a \$10.00 late fee.
